“Permit Parking only 2 hours before through two hours after baseball games”

These signs are legally unenforceable legally at this point and either have to be changed or removed to be enforceable. ONS Board members Wanda Rasheed and John A. Colabelli met with Carla and City Engineers last week to discuss options. We have four options to consider.
