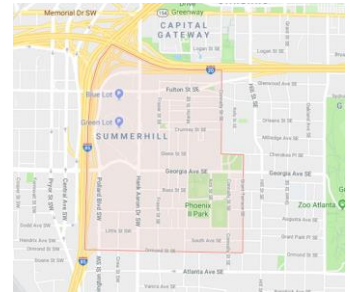

Parking Sign Discussion/Vote

The current issue we are discussing and voting on this evening is specific to the signs pictured at the left that read.

“Permit Parking only 2 hours before through two hours after baseball games”

These signs are legally unenforceable at this point and either have to be changed or removed to be enforceable. Last month (April) we voted to change these to Permit Parking Only” with potential limitations on enforcement times TBD pending further info.

The city engineers have advised that best practice is to limit the enforcement to a window between 1 AM and 1 PM, 7 Days a week which covers most neighborhood event windows, business windows, restaurants, retail and stadium events. Residents would however have to get a yearly permit. 20\$ per permit, yearly. Each permit comes with 2 guest passes
