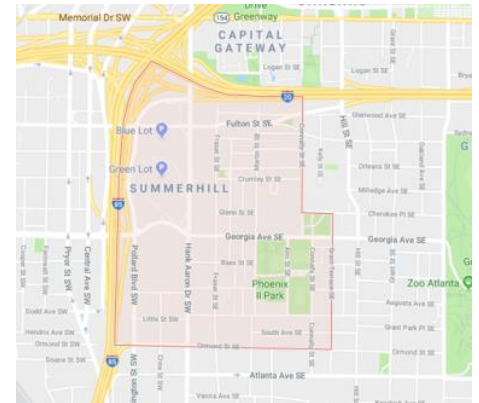

ONS Code of Conduct: Adopted at the August 2017 meeting

- ✓ **One Mic:** When one person has the floor they shall not be interrupted or spoken over.
- ✓ **Time limit:** Whoever has the floor should quickly and concisely make their point. A limit of 2 minutes per comment will be enforced. No one voice should dominate the meeting or topic.
- ✓ **Step Up/Step back:** If you wish to be heard, raise your hand and ask to be heard. If you have already spoken, step back and give others a chance.
- ✓ **Point of View:** We are a diverse community with sometimes differing points of view. Respect those differences and allow others the ability to express themselves.
- ✓ **Active Listening:** Commit to active listening and stay engaged.
- ✓ **Agenda:** Respect the agenda and the need to move along. We typically have more to get through than the time allotted and need to push forward so we can get in and out within the allotted time.
- ✓ **Parking Lot:** If we do not have enough time to address a topic properly then we may need to move it to a parking lot and address it in next meeting or at a special meeting.

Voting: You must have attended at least one meeting in the 12months to qualify to vote
